PARKING

There are a number of handicap spaces around the Housing properties. When tenants request a handicap space, we do our best to accommodate them. However, just because you request a space, that doesn't mean the space belongs to you exclusively. Anyone with a valid handicap tag or license can park in any handicap space.

Also, just a reminder, tenants are allowed one vehicle per unit in the parking lots. That vehicle must have a residential parking permit hanging from the rear-view mirror. If you have more than one vehicle, or if you are having company, extra vehicles must park along the streets.
