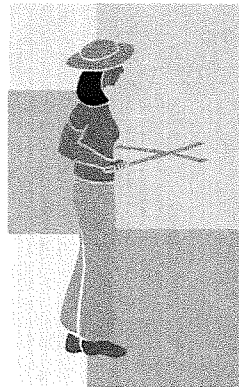
New Faces at Housing Authority

REMINDER TO TENANTS

Tenants are reminded that it is their responsibility to keep their yards clear of obstructions as the grounds crew will be mowing.

*Also as part of the lease agreement tenants must make sure to water their grass or they will receive a **lease violation**.*

Tenants are also responsible for their hoses and sprinklers. There will be a charge for them if they turn up missing or need to be replaced.

No indoor furniture can be left outside to be used as yard furniture.

No swimming pools are allowed on Housing Authority property.

RANCH BURGERS

These beef burgers stay juicy and delicious on the grill or stove top. Serve on buns with your favorite condiments.

2 pounds lean ground beef

1 (1oz.)pkg ranch dressing mix

1 egg, slightly beaten

3/4 cup crushed saltine crackers

1 onion, chopped

Preheat the grill on high heat. In a bowl, mix ground beef, dressing mix, egg, crushed crackers, and onion. Form into hamburger patties.

Place patties on the grill, cook 5 minutes per side or until well done.

PARKING

Do you have your parking tag displayed so it is visible to the Police Officer when they are patrolling?

Your parking tag must be hanging from the mirror or taped to the lower corner of the windshield.

If it isn't visible to the Officer, your vehicle may be towed.



RENT

Rent is due by the 1st of each month, and must be paid no later than the 5th day of the month. If the 5th falls on a weekend or holiday, you can leave your rent in the drop box next to the front door of the Housing office. Rent received after the 5th day of the month will result in a \$20.00 late fee and a 14-Day Notice. After receiving two 14-Day Notices, a third late payment in a 6-month period will result in a 30-Day Eviction Notice.

BUGS!

If you notice any kind of bug or insect problem in your apartment, please call the office as soon as possible. We have an exterminator who comes in once a week.

If a problem isn't reported and taken care of, the bugs or insects can spread to neighboring apartments.
