TWO COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS

The Housing Authority will again be offering a college scholarship to one or more graduating seniors who are residents of a public housing complex owned and operated by the Great Falls Housing Authority or whose family is assisted with housing rents through the Section 8 program at the Great Falls Housing Authority. The scholarship amount this year will be **\$1400.00**. The scholarship will be awarded based on the application, scholastic achievement, leadership, educational goals and consistent school attendance. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5. Applications are available at the Housing Authority office or at each high school, and must be completed and returned to the Housing office by Friday, April 10th.



ALSO, the HAI Group have notified us that they will be awarding 50 scholarships worth \$2,500 each!!! Applicants must currently be residing in public or Section 8 housing for at least 6 months, be a high school senior, a current college student, be a US citizen, and have a GPA of at least 2.0.
