Housing Authority Board Openings

The Great Falls City Commission is seeking applications for three openings on the Housing Authority Board of Commissioners. One Tenant Commissioner will represent the elderly (62 years or older) and serve a two-year term, one Tenant Commissioner will represent families and serve a two-year term and one Commissioner with a legal background will serve a five-year term. Board meetings are held the third Thursday of each month at noon for approximately two hours.

Applications are available at the City Manager's Office in the Civic Center, Room 201, the Housing Authority office at 1500 Chowen Springs Loop, or may be obtained from the Advisory Boards section on the City's website at www.greatfallsmt.net. The application deadline is Friday, May 13, 2016 by 4:30 p.m. Applications may be turned in at the Civic Center or the Housing Authority office.

SPICY TACO BAKE

2 lbs lean ground beef

1 box (16 oz) lasagna noodles

1 (48 oz) jar spaghetti sauce

2 packets taco seasoning

2 packages (12-16 oz) shredded Mexican cheese

1 small can jalapeno peppers or green chilies added to the spaghetti sauce.

1 small can black olives

Shredded lettuce

Picante sauce

Sour cream

1. In skillet brown ground beef, drain, then add taco seasoning packets with $\frac{1}{2}$ cup water. Mix thoroughly. Boil noodles (add a few drops of oil to keep from sticking).
2. In a large 9X13 pan (spray bottom first with non-stick spray) put 1 layer of noodles, cover with a layer of cheese, then meat, then sauce, adding chilies or peppers with sauce. Continue adding layers until you have about 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches left at top of pan. At last layer make sure to cover completely with cheese.
3. Bake in a 350 degree oven for 35 minutes covered with foil, then uncover and bake another 15 minutes.
4. To serve add shredded lettuce and sour cream in dollops on top then cover with black olives. Serve with picante sauce on the side.
